All American Marine, Inc. unveils the new Amerikat 32.

Bellingham, WA May 3rd, 2006: All American Marine Inc. is pleased to debut a new model of hydrofoil-assisted power catamarans at the Newport Boat Show in Newport Beach, CA. The Amerikat is the first production line of boats offered by custom boat builder All American Marine, which has over 18 years of building experience. Company owners, Matt Mullett and Pat Pitsch, worked closely with naval architect Nic de Waal of Teknicraft Design, located in Auckland, New Zealand to create the Amerikat 32. "The Amerikat isn't the run-of-the-mill recreation boat. This vessel will be appreciated most by a select group of discerning boating enthusiasts, who want a soft ride at high-speeds, fuel economy, comfortable interior accommodations and a sleek design," says Mullett.

The Amerikat 32 contains Teknicraft's unique hull shape and hydrofoil system, which works in unison to give the Amerikat superior advantages over other catamarans and mono hulls. The hydrofoil functions similar to an aircraft wing, which is used to create lift. The underwater wing provides a lifting force equal to approximately one-third of the vessel's weight at cruising speed, which decreases resistance and allows the Amerikat to travel at higher speeds with less horsepower and lower fuel consumption.

Teknicraft's Nic de Waal is excited to see the start of a production model; "It is great to see the technology that we have developed over many years in high-speed commercial and para-military applications is now being applied to boats in the leisure market. The advantages will be equally appreciated by the recreational enthusiasts as they are by the commercial sector."

Constructed out of durable and lightweight marine grade aluminum, the Amerikat 32 distinctly displays the same sleekness found in comparable fiberglass boats. The catamaran is powered by twin Volvo D4-260 diesel stern drives, each yielding 260 hp @ 3500 rpm. The super-charged Volvo engines provide a cruising speed of 40 mph

and a top speed of 44 mph @ 3650 rpm. The vessel can be controlled from the main helm station in the pilothouse or from an aft deck station in the cockpit.

The interior cabin of the Amerikat 32 features beautiful Jatoba hardwood craftsmanship with inlaid Teak and Holly flooring. Comfortable accommodations are provided by the private queen-sized stateroom and convertible settee. A private head and shower are also included with plenty of headroom. The Amerikat is equipped with a functional galley that includes a diesel range, which also converts into a cabin heater.

The Amerikat 32 features many amenities and offers performance that is unparalleled to other power catamarans and mono hulls. The oversized cockpit, integrated wave-piercer, and excellent seakeeping ability are just a few of the distinguishable traits that put the Amerikat 32 in a class of its own. High-speed performance, quality craftsmanship, and advanced hydrofoil technology make All American Marine's new Amerikat 32 the perfect choice for an enjoyable and unforgettable cruise.
