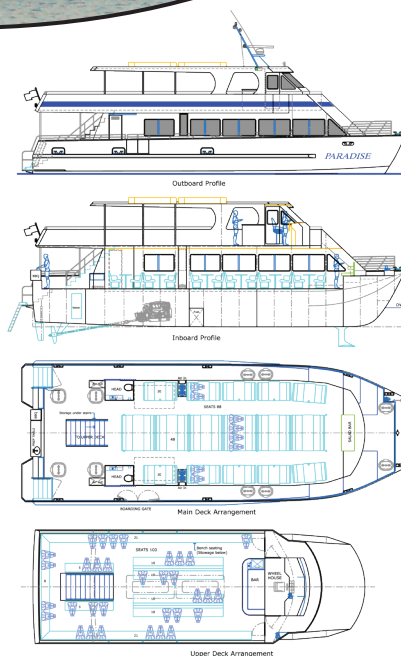

The Hoku Nai'a, meaning Dolphin Star, will primarily be used for a Wild Dolphin Watch cruise that departs twice daily from Waianae Boat Harbor on the south shore of Oahu. Hoku Nai'a is specifically designed for passenger comfort and panoramic views from both the main deck and elevated observation deck.

On board amenities include two stainless steel professional grade barbeques, a custom built salad bar buffet, 360 degree wrap around walkways, and easily accessible dive ladders. The main cabin

features tables with bench seating and plenty of additional seating is offered on the covered observation deck which provides guests with shelter from the tropical sun.

The vessel's unique design offers all passengers a smooth ride and extreme comfort as the hull provides a cushioned effect when encountering waves and sea swells. The catamaran is also highly stable and has outstanding seakeeping ability.
