

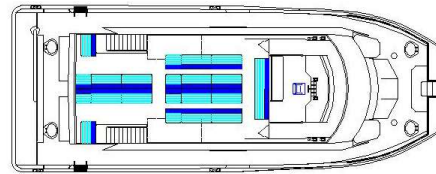
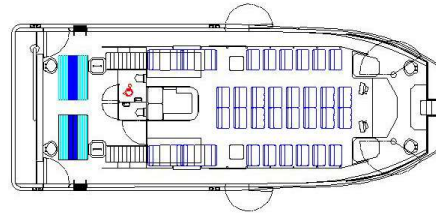
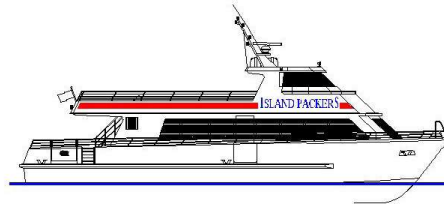

Island Packers contracts with the National Park Service to ferry campers and day trippers from Ventura, California, to Channel Islands National Park, 20 miles across the Santa Barbara Channel. The 65'x 24', 149 passenger Teknicraft catamaran has replaced two of the company's 48-passenger monohulled vessels.

The Islander makes the crossing to Santa Cruz, the largest and most popular of the islands, in less than 45 minutes vs. over 2hrs. previously. The vessel's design also allows for quicker and safer loading and unloading of its passengers. "She is set up so that it is comfortable to load from the stern or the bow, on either side and in heavy weather", said Alex Brodie, co-owner and captain of the company's new high-speed catamaran.
